FOO TAK BUILDING

A nondescript building that blends in with the rest of the structures on the same block, the 14-storey Foo Tak Building is a hotbed of local artists and designers. The hub began its life when the landlord decided to offer units in this building at reduced rent in 2003 with an aim to support emerging local artists.

Despite its unassuming exterior, Foo Tak Building now contains a thriving community with artists' studios, workshops, art galleries and other culture-related establishments such as publishers, cultural organisations and activist groups.

Parts of the building are open to the public for scheduled film screenings, concerts, workshops, seminars and other events. The tenants themselves are active participants in seminars and discussion groups on local current issues, demonstrating the close relationship between society and the arts. A small portion of Foo Tak Building functions as a dormitory for visiting overseas artists, promoting cross-cultural exchange.
